






Women count for roughly half the world's population yet they occupy less than a quarter of political seats. Rwanda is an outlier, with more women in power, proportionally than any other country. Rwanda is the first country in the world with female majority in parliament, with 61.3% in the Chamber of Deputies and 37.4% in the Senate.

Rwanda-Burundi Border-Level 2: Exercise Increased Caution







Education

Documentation

To provide a documentation centre to record evidence of the genocide, testimonies of genocide survivors and details of genocide victims.



There are also






